#### PG601 Perfect White

Glossy and opaque. A stable white glaze to use as a base, a liner or an overlap with other glazes.

#### PG602 Incredible Black

Glossy and opaque mottled black with a wide range of uses. By itself, the blue, khaki and warm brown breaking hues bounce from a black field. Creates unique combinations with most glazes in our line.

#### PG607 Nassau Blue

Glossy and opaque mottled blue. Medium-to-light blue that offers great interest by itself or plays well with others.

## PG608 Cobalt Blue

Glossy and semi-opaque. A bright, true cobalt blue with hints of mottling when applied thicker.
